Over time, CAAAV has broadened its work to focus on a wide range of issues affecting our communities, including concentrated urban poverty, displacement and gentrification, police violence, criminalization of youth and workers, and access to social services. Our strategy is guided by a global analysis of migration, labor, and poverty, and how these experiences are shaped in the U.S. by nationality, immigration status, gender, race, and class.
